## Typhoon Chanthu

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to Typhoon Chanthu, port and airport terminals in Shanghai and Ningbo have been halted on Monday September 13<sup>th</sup> until further notice.

### Air:

- All flights at Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) and Shanghai Hongqiao Airport (SHA) as well as Ningbo Lishe International Airport (NGB) were cancelled as of Monday Sep 13<sup>th</sup> 11 a.m. local time until further notice.
- Import and export operations at air cargo terminals and warehouses remain normal.

### Ocean:

- Container import and export services at Ningbo and Shanghai port terminals were halted on Sunday Sep 12<sup>th</sup> and Monday Sep 13<sup>th</sup> 11 a.m. local time respectively until further notice.
- Shanghai WaiGaoQiao + YangShan terminals/depots stopped empty pickups as of Sunday Sep 12<sup>th</sup> 7 p.m. local time and have been closed for all activities since Monday Sep 13<sup>th</sup> 6 a.m. local time until further notice.
- YangShan warehouse has suspended outbound operations since Monday Sep 13<sup>th</sup> 12 p.m. until further notice.
- CFS warehouses at WaiGaoQiao stopped operations by strong winds effective Monday Sep 13<sup>th</sup> 5 p.m. until further notice.

### Customs:

- All customs declaration/clearance activities are not affected; however, with container shifting suspended at container yards, cargo inspection services have been suspended.

Please expect to experience a 3-5 day delay in both flights and vessels calling and departure. We will continue to monitor the situation closely with our service providers and will issue further updates.
