## **Vessel Zim Kingston 12N – Service disruption**

Dear Valued Customer,

Between October 21<sup>st</sup> and October 22<sup>nd</sup>, on its way from Pusan to Vancouver, the vessel MV ZIM KINGSTON encountered severe weather conditions.

The Canadian coast guard and other local authorities were notified, and the vessel was instructed to anchor off the Canadian coast. All crew members are reported safe. At this point we are waiting for further instructions on when the ship can berth and start unloading operations.

We do expect that all units on board the vessel will be delayed. If any C.H. Robinson containers were lost or damaged, our teams will communicate with the affected customers and share information as it becomes available.
