## Section 301 List 4A Exclusion Process Announced

Dear Valued Customer,

The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) published a notice with instructions on how to file requests for exclusions on goods found on Section 301 – Tranche 4A.

**Requests for Section 301 List 4A exclusions may be submitted between October 31, 2019 and January 31, 2020 for goods covered under list 4A that currently are subject to a 15% tariff.**

Requests should be filed through the USTR's Electronic Portal:

Any exclusions granted will be retroactive from September 1, 2019, which was the effective date of list 4A, and will be effective for one year.
