General Rate Increase (GRI) Transpacific Eastbound (Asia to the U.S. & Canada)

Dear Valued Customer,

The ocean carriers that provide service from Asia to the United States and Canada have announced and filed a General Rate Increase (GRI) to the levels noted below. The effective GRI will be applied to all containers in-gated at the origin receiving terminal on or after May 15, 2020*.

C.H. Robinson will continue to evaluate the market to ensure each customer receives the most competitive offering in the marketplace. These levels are pre-filed rates consistent with the ocean carriers to ensure FMC (U.S. Federal Maritime Commission) compliance. We will continue to monitor the market and levels to ensure our rates remain competitive.
