## **United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Implementation**

Dear Valued U.S. Import Customer,

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued a memorandum providing guidance for claiming preferential tariff treatment under the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA). The procedures outlined in the memorandum are in place until the final regulations are implemented.

As announced by the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR), implementation will take effect for goods entered on or after July 1, 2020. The North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) rules will apply through June 30, 2020. Final implementation instructions will be issued prior to the effective date.

The memorandum includes, but is not limited to, the following subjects pertinent to importations under USMCA:

- Rules of Origin, including Rules of Origin for Automotive Goods
- Regional Value Content (RVC) Calculation Methods
- De Minimis (for non-textile products)
- > Treatment of Sets
- Transit and Transshipment
- > Eligible Articles, including Eligibility for Textiles and Apparel
- Merchandise Processing Fee (MPF) Exemption
- Country of Origin Marking Rules
- Making a Preference Claim, including Post-Importation Claims
- > Certification or Other Document Requirements, and Recordkeeping Requirements
