Cyclone Nisarga - West India

Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to share an update related to Cyclone Nisarga which is expected to hit the West coast of India. The India Meteorological Department (IMD) recently shared the following states in Western India, more specifically parts of Maharashtra (Mumbai, Palghar, Thane, Raigad), Goa and Gujarat will see strong winds and heavy rainfall as Cyclone Nisarga makes landfall. As per IMD, the sea conditions will likely be rough in the next 18 hours.

Port authorities are closely monitoring the system and could take precautionary measures as deemed fit. If the cyclone poses a threat, there could be possible situations of reduced berthing windows. For now, however, the situation remains stable and port operations continue to function as normal. Additionally, there could be possible power outages and connectivity challenges across the areas impacted by the cyclone.
