Amendment of the Export Administration Regulations People's Republic of China, Russia and Venezuela *** UPDATE on AES Filing Requirement ***

Dear Valued U.S. Export Customer,

Further to our Client Advisory dated June 19, 2020, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) has announced revisions to the Electronic Export Information (EEI) filing requirement in the Automated Export System (AES) for items destined for China, Russia and Venezuela, military end use/end user rule.

- The Electronic Export Information (EEI) filing requirement for items subject to <u>Supplement No. 2 to Part</u>
 744 destined for China, Russia, and Venezuela will become <u>effective on June 29, 2020</u>.
- EEI filing for exports to China, Russia or Venezuela of items controlled by Export Control Classification Numbers (ECCNs) not listed in <u>Supplement No. 2 to Part 744</u> will not be required until September 27, 2020.
